### WHAT TO BRING

### ATTIRE

1. Masterclasses, recitals, and rehearsals: casual clothing, comfortable, but keep it nice.
2. Recreation and free time: swim suites, beach towel, sportswear, but nothing inappropriate.
3. Concert Attire is ALL BLACK.
  - a. MEN: ALL BLACK slacks, long sleeve shirt, belts (if needed), socks, and shoes.
  - b. WOMEN: ALL BLACK dress or slacks and blouse, socks, and shoes. Please consider dress length.
  - c. No flip-flops, tennis shoes, or jeans, please keep the attire professional.

#### DORM SUPPLIES

1. XL twin sheets, blanket, pillow and pillow case.
2. Bath towels, washcloth, soap, and other toiletries.
3. For your comfort, you may wish to bring a small fan.

#### MISCELLANEOUS

1. Medical supplies (if needed) – For students bringing medications and medical supplies, they will be required to report it to the summer camp staff at check-in.
2. Money: most activities will be provided as part of the camp. It is recommended that you do not bring excess amounts of cash with you. Bring only what is needed for drinks, snacks, and so forth.
